Send proof of accreditation for your Team/Dojo/Association in your home country. Once reviewed and satisfactory we can proceed on this basis:

2. Pay your entry fees online. Please note that fees are non-refundable.
3. Send an email to [pska@pska.ca](mailto:pska@pska.ca) with a copy of your passport so your name can be spelled correctly.
4. The invitation letter will be sent to you via email after we have verified a completed registration for the tournament.
5. Please note that an invitation letter does not guarantee that a travel visa will be issued. PSKA/CSKA, or any of its affiliates, cannot contact the Canadian embassy/consulate on your behalf. We cannot provide any assistance on the visa application other than the invitation letter nor any assistance with sponsorship, travel arrangements, guides, etc.
