# **INFORMATION**

## **General**

Please ensure you are in the correct division prior to the tournament.

Consolidation or Separation of divisions will occur at the discretion of the tournament organizers. Competitors may be moved up or down in an age group depending on the number of competitors in the age division.

Refunds will only be given for medical reasons OR when the consolidation of divisions results in the cancellation of a match for the competitor.

For safety reasons, competitors will not be allowed to wear regular eye glasses. Safety glasses and contact lenses are allowed. No jewelry or body piercing ornaments.

Hair: tied back (male & female).

Nails: short.

The tournament will be run following the rules established by the Japan Karate Association with modifications allowed by the organizers:

## **Judges Attire**

Gray pants, white long sleeve shirt, JKA/burgundy tie, please bring your own whistle.

## **Kata**

For kata divisions (white to black belts) only shotokan Katas will be performed/judged. For eliminations, Taikyoku Shodan, Heian Shodan to Heian Godan, and Tekki Shodan will be asked. Please refer to the table below.

For black belt divisions, in addition to Shitei katas (Heian Shodan to Heian Godan and Tekki Shodan), Sentei Kata might be asked if all participants know them.

For kata divisions with a low number of participants, we might directly go to Tokui kata (your choice of kata).

### **Here is the list of Shotokan Katas accepted:**

Taikyoku Shodan - Heian Shodan - Heian Nidan - Heian Sandan - Heian Yondan - Heian Godan - Tekki Shodan - Tekki Nidan - Tekki Sandan - Jion - Bassai-Dai - Kanku-Dai - Empi - Hangetsu - Jitte - Gankaku - Bassai-Sho - Kanku-Sho - Chinte - Unsu - Sochin - Nujushiho - Gojushiho -Dai - Goshushiho-Sho - Meikyo - Wankan

Tiebreak Rule for Kata Matches (Item 39 JKA Rules) Flag System The Head Judge will randomly choose another kata to be performed by the 2 competitors. For scoring, the competitors will perform the same kata again. If there is still a draw, the lowest score that was dropped will be added for a total score. If there is still a draw, the highest score that was dropped will be added as well for a total score. If finally there is still a draw, the competitors will perform a different kata.

## **Jyu Kumite (free sparring)**

In a match, all techniques – punches, kicks, strikes, have to be done with control. **For brown and black belts**, jodan/head area techniques can score when stopped approximately within 5 cm of the target for kicks and 2 cm for hand techniques, and may be delivered with light touch (skin touch), without causing impact. A light touch to the target/skin touch is only permitted for brown and black belts.

**From green to purple belts**, jodan/head area can score when stopped approximately within 10 cm of the target for kicks and 5 cm for hand techniques. Any contact to the head will be penalized.

Any contact to the throat, unless received by the recipient's own fault, must result in a warning or penalty.

If there is a draw, another match will be held. This re-match is called **Sai-Shiai**. If this re-match ends up in a draw, a second re-match called **Sai-Sai-Shiai** will be held. However, the Head Judge will order that this second re-match is a “**sudden death**” match meaning that the competitor that scores first is declared the winner. After a second re-match the Judges must determine a winner.

## **Round Robin Jyu Kumite (for 3 and 4 competitors in a division)**

The winner of a group in Individual round robin-competition is the athlete having the most victory points.

A win is 3 points, a draw with a Wasari for each competitor is 1 point each, a loss is 0 point.

In cases where there is a tie between two or more Athletes in a division, having the same number of victory points, the criteria below will be applied in the specified order. This means that if a winner is found after one of the criteria, the following criteria will not have to be applied.

- 1) Winner of the bout between the Athletes involved in the tie.
- 2) Higher number of total scores obtained in favour through all bouts.
- 3) Extra bout allowing HANTEI (Sai-Shiai - sudden death)
