Competition Format

Pattern Events

Individual Pattern (Male & Female)

- Each competitor will perform 2 rounds of patterns as follows:

Rounds	10 th – 6 th Gup White to Green	5 th Gup – 1 st Gup Green-Blue to Red-Black	1 st Dan Black Belt	2 nd Dan Black Belt	3 rd Dan Black Belt
Round 1	Own Selection				
Round 2	Own Selection		Compulsory Pattern		

Own Selection

- Competitor's own selected pattern. Competitor may choose any pattern from Chon Ji up to the competitor's belt rank.
- 9th Gup competitors will perform Chon Ji for both rounds.
- 10th Gup competitors will perform Saju Magki (Round 1) and Saju Jirugi (Round 2)

Compulsory pattern

- A compulsory pattern will be randomly selected by the computer to be performed by all competitors in a category. The patterns selected will be from Chon Ji up to the competitor's belt rank.

- Patterns will be performed individually.
- Competitors with the highest 3 points after 2 rounds will be awarded medals.
- In the event of a draw, affected competitors will perform a tie-breaker round with a pattern of their own selection.



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Team Pattern (Male & Female)

- Each team shall perform 1 pattern of their own choice.
- Judging will commence at the start of the pattern and conclude at the end of the pattern. No points will be given for entrance and exit of the competition ring.
- Teams with the highest 3 points after 1 round will be awarded medals.
- In the event of a draw, affected teams will perform a tie-breaker round with a pattern of their own selection. Teams may perform the same pattern.

Sparring Events

Individual Free Sparring (Male & Female)

- Competitors will compete in a “knock-out format”.
- Draws will be done randomly via the computer.
- Competitors will spar in the following format:

Preliminary to Semi Finals	1 Round @ 1 minute	1 Round @ 1 minute 30 seconds	1 Round @ 1 minute 30 seconds
Finals	2 Rounds @ 1 minute per round	2 Rounds @ 1 minute 30 seconds per round	2 Rounds @ 1 minute 30 seconds per round

- In the event of a draw, the competitors will compete in a tie-breaker round of similar duration.
- In the event of a draw after the tie-breaker round, the competitor will compete in a sudden-death round. The sudden-death round will conclude after a competitor scores.
- No rounds for 3rd place will be held. 2 bronze medals will be awarded to the losing competitor in both the Semi-Final rounds.
- Sparring Gear Rules applies (see next page).



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Team Sparring (Male & Female)

- Teams will compete in a “knock-out format”.
- Draws will be done randomly via the computer.
- Teams will compete in 3 rounds, with one competitor per round in the following format: -

- In the event of a draw, each team will nominate 1 team member to compete in a tie-breaker round of similar duration.
- In the event of a draw after the tie-breaker round, each team will nominate 1 team member compete in a sudden-death round. The sudden-death round will conclude after a team scores.
- No rounds for 3rd place will be held. 2 sets of bronze medals will be awarded to the losing team in both the Semi-Final rounds.
- Sparring Gear Rules applies (see below).

Sparring Gear Rules: -

- The following sparring gears are **COMPULSORY**: -
 - ITF styled gloves (Closed fingers gloves only; No weighted gloves / kickboxing gloves allowed)
 - ITF styled foot protector
 - Mouth guard
 - Groin guard (for all male competitors only)
 - Head guard (for all competitors 12 years old & below)
- The following sparring gears are **OPTIONAL**: -
 - Chest guard
 - Shin guard
 - Head guard (optional for 13 years old & above)



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- All sparring gear used must be of operational condition. No damaged or ill fitted gears will be allowed for safety reasons.
- Competitors are responsible to bring their own sparring gears. The Organisers will not be providing any sparring gears.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- The above Sparring Gear Rules are designed for the safety of competitors and will be **STRICTLY** enforced by the Organisers. The Organisers reserves the right to disqualify any competitors from competing in the sparring events should there be breeches of the above rules and no refund will be entertained.

Special Needs Event

Individual Pattern (Male & Female)

- There are 5 categories in the Pattern event i.e.
 - Men 7-12 yrs
 - Men 13 – 15 yrs
 - Men 16 – 18 yrs
 - Men >19 yrs
 - Ladies – Open
- Each competitor will perform 1 pattern of their own choice individually i.e. one by one.
- Competitors may choose any pattern from Chon Ji up to the competitor's belt rank. 10th Gup competitors may select Saju Magki or Saju Jirugi.
- Competitors may perform their chosen Pattern independently; together with an instructor or partner; or with prompting.
- A maximum of only 2 persons are allowed to assist the competitors in the ring during his/her performance.
- Judging will be based on Individual Merit, according to the following criteria/s :
 - Presentation - Independence / Confidence / Smoothness / Understanding / Interaction with Instructor/s or Partner/s
 - Correctness of Pattern / Technique
 - Power – Stance, Breathing, Balance, Coordination, Focus



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- Level of Difficulty
- Points will be awarded by a panel of Senior Judges. Judges' decision is final.
- Medals are awarded for highest points achieved within each category i.e. 1 GOLD, 1 SILVER, 1 BRONZE , Medals of Achievement.

Special Skills / Techniques

- There are 5 categories in the Special Skills / Technique event i.e.
 - Men 7-12 yrs
 - Men 13 – 15 yrs
 - Men 16 – 18 yrs
 - Men >19 yrs
 - Ladies – Open
- Each competitor will perform their Special Skills / Technique individually i.e. one by one.
- Competitors are given a minimum of 1.5 mins to a maximum of 2 minutes to perform their Special Skills / Techniques.
- Competitors may perform any Special Skills / Technique of their choice i.e. Arranged or Choreographed Self-Defense, Pad- Work, Mat-Work, Pattern Application, Step Sparring, Exercises, Promise Sparring, Leg or Hand Techniques.
- There is strictly no contact Free Sparring for the Special Needs category.
- Competitors may perform their chosen Special Skills / Techniques independently; duet together with an instructor or partner; or with guidance and prompting.
- A maximum of only 2 persons are allowed to assist the competitors in the ring during his/her performance.
- Judging will be based on Individual Merit, according to the following criteria/s :
 - Presentation - Independence / Confidence / Smoothness / Understanding / Interaction with Instructor/s or Partner/s
 - Correctness of Technique
 - Power – Stance, Breathing, Balance, Coordination, Focus
 - Level of Difficulty and Creativity

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SMART Special Skills / Techniques

- There are 5 categories in the Special Skills / Technique event i.e.
 - Men 7-12 yrs
 - Men 13 – 15 yrs
 - Men 16 – 18 yrs
 - Men >19 yrs
 - Ladies – Open
- Competitors are to perform their Special Skills / Technique individually i.e. one by one.
- Competitors are given a minimum of 1.5mins to a maximum of 2 minutes to perform and show their Special Skills / Techniques.
- Competitors may perform any Special Skills / Technique of their choice i.e. Arranged or Choreographed Self-Defense, Pad- Work, Mat-Work, Pattern Application, Step Sparring, Exercises, Promise Sparring, Leg or Hand Techniques.
- There is strictly no contact Free Sparring for the Special Needs category.
- Competitors may perform their chosen Special Skills / Techniques independently; duet together with an instructor or partner; or with guidance and prompting.
- A maximum of only 2 persons are allowed to assist the competitors in the ring during his performance.
- Judging will be based on Individual Merit, according to the following criteria/s :
