- Juniors are defined as being competitors aged under 12 years.
- Colts are defined as being competitors aged 12 - 17 years.
- Seniors are defined as being competitors aged 18 – 39 years.
- Masters are defined as being competitors aged 40 years & over.
- Ages are taken as at **31st December 2021**.
- For Kumite events, competitors 50 years and over must provide a medical certificate to the Tournament Organisers certifying that they are fit before being eligible to compete. The certificate must not be more than 60 days old and should be presented to the Organisers by no later than 9am on the day of competition.
- All competitors with 'medic alert' must report to the Tournament Doctor prior to competing to allow the Doctor to familiarise themselves with any special medical needs.
- **Conditions of Entry form MUST be completed and signed** or entries will not be accepted.
- Instructors must sign consent for 6th to 4th kyu Jiyu Kumite competitors.
- TEAM KUMITE EVENTS – Nominations and draws may be revised at the competition and run with time permitting. Mixed Dojo teams allowed. **ALL** teams are limited to three (3) team members plus one (1) reserve.
- TEAM KATA EVENTS – restricted to two (2) teams per dojo per division. Mixed Dojo teams allowed.
- “Open Kumite” Events are open to 3rd kyu and above, 18 – 55 years.
- “Colts Team Kumite” Events are open to 3rd kyu and above, 12-17 years.
- “Open Kata” Events are open to 3rd kyu and above, 18 – 55 years.
- Events may be changed or combined depending on the number of entrants eg. In the case of a category only having a single entry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND INFORMED CONSENT

1. In these conditions: "the Association" shall mean and include Shotokan Karate International Australia Incorporated and Shotokan Karate International Australia New South Wales Branch, it's officers, servants or agents. "Opponent" shall mean any person competing against the competitor.
2. In consideration of the Association accepting my application to enter and compete in the tournament and in further consideration of my opponent competing against me, I hereby agree to abide by the conditions of entry, the rules, by-laws and regulations of the Association.
3. The Association enters into this contract as the Association and as agent for the competitor's opponent. I acknowledge that my participation in the tournament carries with it a real risk of personal injury.
4. I acknowledge and agree that the Association shall not be liable whether in tort or contract or otherwise for any loss or damage or injury whatsoever to my person or property whilst participating in or otherwise attending at the tournament, howsoever caused or occurring including without limiting the forgoing, the negligence, breach of contract, wilful act or default of the Association and whether or not such loss or damage or injury occurs within or adjacent to any property occupied by the Association.
5. I acknowledge and agree that my opponent shall not be liable whether in tort or contract or otherwise for any loss or damage or injury whatsoever to my person or property whilst participating in or otherwise attending at the tournament, howsoever caused by or occurring including without limiting the forgoing, the negligence, breach of contract, wilful act or default of my opponent and whether or not such loss or damage or injury to me occurs within or adjacent to any property occupied by the Association.
6. I authorise the Association to contract on my behalf to exclude my liability as an opponent whether such arises in tort or contract or otherwise for any loss or damage or injury to another competitor however caused or occurring including but without limiting the forgoing, the negligence, breach of contract, wilful act or default by myself.
7. I expressly agree to and do hereby waive any rights that I may have which are in any way inconsistent with the foregoing.
8. I give permission for images, photographs and/or video to be taken during the competition and waive the right to inspect or approve the finished product wherein my likeness appears. I understand this permission signifies that photographic or video recordings of me may be electronically displayed via the Internet.
