- Team arrival to Riga, registration and weight-in control (from 14:00)

REGULATIONS:

1. Participants. Club's team members in age from 5 to 15 years old and with qualification 10 gup -2^{nd} Dan, which will Included in the Team application list. There are 8 groups:

Number of participants is unlimited. Competitors need to show national passport. Athletes will participate at their club's responsibility.

1.1. Entry fee. The cost is 35 EUR / per competitor for all kinds of program without limitation.

1.2. CHECK POINT FOR REGISTRATION

Coach check-in. On **June 17**, in sport hall the team leaders check-in the arrival and sign the original application for participation, pay all necessary fees for the participation & accommodation of whole team.

Registration for participants and weigh-in will be after coach check-in (carry a passport, medical sports insurance for the period of the competition).

Penalties. If the weight of the athlete does not correspond to the officially declared weight, then the athlete must pay an extra fee of **10 EUR** for admission to the competition in the corresponding real weight of the weight category.

PROGRAM OF THE GAMES

2. Taekwon-do ITF competitions programm

It is necessary to observe the Tournament rules of the International Taekwon-Do Federation (ITF) and Latvian Taekwon-do Federation (LTF). Taekwon-do ITF competitions program consist from 2 (two) kinds of competitions:

- Individual Patterns "Tul"
- Individual Sparring "Matsogi"

- 2.2.1. Participants demonstrating Taekwon-do ITF free sparring technique.
- 2.2.2. Blows to the head by the hands restricted in age division Child-1 (6-8 years)!
- 2.2.3. According to the participants age there will be following sparring categories:

2.2.4. Tournament organizer can merge weight categories in same age division if there will be less than 4 competitors.

2.2.5. Compulsory safety equipment.

Coaches must ensure that the participants have all Taekwon-do ITF sparring protective equipment:

- Gloves (open palm gloves or boxing gloves not bigger than 10 oz) blue and red color. Other colors will not be allowed;
- **Head guards** with close top, blue and red color. Other colors will not be allowed;
- **Feet protectors,** ITF standard safety equipment for sparring can be any neutral color and brand;
- Shin guards, Mouth guard are compulsory for all ages;
- **Groin protector** is compulsory only for male for all ages;
- Chest protector (inside Dobok) is compulsory only for female from 14 y. old;

3. Universal part of program

Representatives of any other kind of martial arts can take part in this part of competitions.


Program of universal part consist from 4 (four) kinds of competitions:

- Teams Relay race (5-15 years)
- Gladiator's fights (7-13 years)
- Power Test (11-15 years)
- TOTAL FORCE and ENERGY Test (11-15 years)

3.1. Team Relay race

- 3.1.1. Age divisions: Child-1 (5-8y.), Child-2 (9-10y.), Cadet (11-13y.), Junior (14-15y.)
- 3.1.2. <u>4 (four)</u> athletes (boys or/and girls) are **united in a team** competing in overcoming the obstacle course with other teams. Competitions are held on the Olympic system (with elimination).
- 3.1.3. The team participating in the relay can be dressed in any sports uniform (without shoes), but in the same style (Dobok or shorts and T-shirt or tracksuit etc.).
- 3.1.4. The club can declare an unlimited number of teams consisting of 4 athletes (boys and girls) from the same age division. One and the same athlete can not participate in different teams.
- 3.1.5. Before the start of the teams will be given the opportunity to test the track.

3.2. Gladiator's fights

3.2.1. Age divisions:

Male: Child-1 (7-8y.), Child-2 (9-10y.), Cadet (11-13y.) Female: Child-1 (7-8y.), Child-2 (9-10y.), Cadet (11-13y.)

- 3.2.2. Competition is going individually, without weigh classes in the same age division.
- 3.2.3. Two competitors "red" and "blue", armed with special inflatable bats climb the inflatable platform in the form of an elevation, located in the centre of the inflatable ring, to demonstrate their agility and strength. The duration of the bout is 1 min. or up to 2 (two) falls from the platform.
- 3.2.4. The winner is one of two fighters who push down from the platform of his/her opponent more times or in case of early victory. The victory can be won ahead of time in the light of the obvious advantage with the score 2:0 or on points 2:1

3.3. «Power Test» (Punch + Kick)

- 3.3.1. Age divisions: Male Cadet (11-13y.), Junior (14-15y.); Female Cadet (11-13y.), Junior (14-15y.);
- 3.3.2. Competitions are held on professional high-precision electronic equipment Real Strike@ in a boxing bag shape.
- 3.3.3. Each of participants has 1 minute for full test of 3 hand technique and 3 kicks.
- 3.3.4. Optional type of hand technique (all kinds of punches and strikes allowed) on a bag equipped with a sensor to measure the impact force.
- 3.3.5. It will be 3 (three) attempts of hand technique (all parts of fist or edge of the palm) and 3 (three) attempts of impacts by the foot (any part of the foot to choose from).
- 3.3.6. In the highest indicators of punches and a kicks are counted and the sum of the highest scores and is taken into final result.
- 3.3.7. According to the results of the electronic meter indicators, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners are determined in each age group.

3.4. Test on the TOTAL FORCE and ENERGY of blows

- 3.4.1. Age divisions: Male Cadet (11-13y.), Junior (14-15y.); Female Cadet (11-13y.), Junior (14-15y.);
- 3.4.2. Competitions are held on professional high-precision electronic equipment Real Strike@ in a boxing bag shape. The electronic system takes into account only blows inflicted with force exceeding the minimum limit of 100kg.
- 3.4.3. For 10 seconds repeated circular **round kick** strokes are carried out on the bag with the instep of foot. Only one attempt will be given for each of participant.
- 3.4.4. According to the results of the electronic meter indicators, 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners are determined in each age group.

4. Accommodation

We offer you two kinds of Hotel booking for accommodation:

- 4.1. You can organize <u>accommodation by yourself</u> though <u>internet</u>. In this case we not offer accommodation free of charge for head of team & for coach. Or if it's necessary, you can order <u>accommodation provided by organizer</u> on the terms of a <u>preliminary reservation with payment of the deposit</u> by the deadline provided in this Regulations (<u>IMPORTANT DATES</u>).

All prices above are **per person** for a **double room** with **breakfast.** The deposit for the reservation at the specified prices must be paid until **10**th **of June, 2022**. Delegations that need Entry viza to Latvia must paid for the Hotel until May **13, 2022**. After deadline, the price increases by 10% and availability is not quaranteed!

Accommodation can be carried out in any hotel independently by your-self. The Organizing Committee guarantees accommodation and transfer only in the case of provisional application from the teams, made up to the deadline.

5. <u>Transfer</u>

5.1.1. If you need transfer from AIRPORT or RAILWAY station to the hotel or/and to the stadium, please contact us before Deadline. Cost for transfer 20.00 EUR per person. Transfer includes a meeting at the airport or the Railway station, bus to the hotel and to the Sports Hall, transfer to the airport or Railway station.

6. Payment methods

- 6.1. There are **two types** of Entry payment for competitors:
 - Bank transfer to organizer bank account. Mandatory for those teams who need an entry visa to Latvia and for those teams who need accommodation provided by organizer. Can use only for prepayment.

7. UMPIRES

Each club (team) ensures at least minimum 1-2 qualified referee for whole competitions days. The referees must be dressed according to the ITF rules. All referees have the obligation to attend the registration together with the competitors from their team.

Attention: The Organizing committee will cover accommodation of 2 nights for 1 or 2 Umpires in 3-stars hotel (in double room with breakfast) and dinner in competition hall during the competition days.

8. TROFIES & AWARDS

- 8.1. For the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each of individual tournament disciplines, participants will be awarded with tournament medals and diplomas, 1- 2-3 place in Team Overall with Big cups.
- 8.2. For 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in Team Relay the team will be awarded by Team Cup and all members by medals & diplomas.
- 8.3. Athletes who have won prizes must be present at the award ceremony and go out for rewards dressed a team sports suit or in Dobok.
- 8.4. Athletes who do not appear at the awards are deprived of their awards. The awards of the athletes who did not qualify for the award will not be given to the coaches!

9. Registration of athletes and teams:

Takes place from 1st of June till 14th of June using the online registration system. Registration is carried out by the head of the delegation or the head coach of the team. The reference to registration will be placed in the upper part of the competition website www.btcup.lv/en/
